

A Resolution Honoring the Service of Chairman Brian J. Moran

WHEREAS Brian J. Moran was elected Chairman of the Democratic Party of Virginia on December 4, 2010 and,

Whereas Chairman Moran made party growth and diversity a priority, adding the Veterans Caucus, the Democratic Latino Organization of Virginia (DLOV), and the Gay Lesbian Bisexual and Transgender (GLBT) Caucus as voting seats on the Steering Committee and,

Whereas Chairman Moran created the DPVA Values-in-Action program, showing Virginians that Democratic values of community, teamwork, and caring can make a lasting difference in the lives of our fellow citizens and,

Whereas Chairman Moran made training our grassroots volunteers, chairs, and local candidates a top priority of the organization, conducting training programs for over 40 committees and more than 250 attendees in 2012 alone and,

Whereas Chairman Moran's leadership was instrumental in the creation of the 2011 Virginia Summit – the largest grassroots training in the history of the Democratic Party of Virginia and,

Whereas Chairman Moran was a prolific communicator on behalf of the Democratic party, its candidates and issues, conducting hundreds of interviews and press events across the Commonwealth and,

Whereas the organization increased its operating budget each year of his Chairmanship, raising over 3.2 million dollars overall, due largely to the investment of his time and tireless commitment to the calls, events, and meetings necessary for success and,

Whereas Chairman Moran increased support to our party's candidates and campaigns, hosting events for all of our Congressional candidates this cycle as well as dozens of events for local candidates and,

Whereas Chairman Moran pushed our party to develop a true statewide presence by traveling to every corner of Virginia, tens of thousands of miles total, on behalf of the DPVA and,

Whereas Chairman Moran was elected Chair of Virginia's Delegation to the 2012 Democratic National Convention in Charlotte, North Carolina, leading one of the most diverse delegations in Virginia history and successfully representing the Commonwealth at that historic event and,

Whereas Chairman Moran has been a tireless advocate for our Democratic candidates, in particular Senator-Elect Tim Kaine and President Barack Obama; ultimately leading to the historic victories of both men on November 6, 2012 and,

Whereas the Democratic Party of Virginia, its members, staff, and elected officials across the Commonwealth owe a debt a gratitude for his selfless and successful service to our great party, therefore be it
